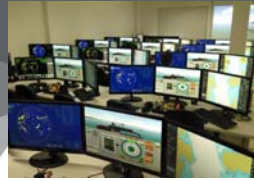


Maritime Resource Management

Coverage:	<p>Maritime Resource Management (MRM) is a training program that builds upon well-established facts as well as the latest research within the human factors area. The message is kept in such a way that it is easily understood and an important purpose is to, after the course, have establish safe attitudes and provided a new set of "tools" that the course participants shall be able to use in their working environments. Another objective is to increase knowledge about human performance and limitations with the purpose of creating a deeper understanding of what can lead humans into lack of situation awareness and complacency. The name "resource management" refers to all the resources that are available to accomplish journeys and other safety-critical tasks in a safe and efficient manner. These resources include officers and crew onboard, pilots, ship's equipment, automated systems, ISM-procedures, manuals, checklists, VTS and more.
